Previously, Veronica spent ten years at Novartis where she held positions of increasing responsibility in Global Marketing up to Director level and helped launch several new therapies against cardiovascular & metabolic diseases and new vaccines against influenza across Europe, the US, Latin America and Asia. Veronica also represented Novartis at the International Federation of Pharmaceutical Manufacturers.

Veronica holds an MBA from INSEAD, and MSc in Economics and Business from Bocconi University and has completed executive programs on Health at Tufts and at Singularity University.

Veronica is an advisor to Loyal VC (Venture Capital) and is a CTI-trained coach.
